Application for GSE International Students

(Students with Foreign Nationalities Living Overseas)

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Application Requirements

Age / Educational Requirements

- Applicants must be 18 years old or over as of April 1 the year in which they plan to enter university.
- Applicants must have completed a 12-year curriculum from a recognized educational system, and received a high school diploma or International Baccalaureate certification.
- Applicants must meet the criteria for admissions to university in her own country.
- Applicants may only apply for spring entry to enter in April each year.

Language proficiency

- Native speakers of English do not have to submit a certificate of proficiency.
- Non-native speakers of English must present a copy of one English proficiency test:
 - · TOEFL PBT 500+ · TOEFL iBT 61+ · IELTS 5.5+ · Cambridge FCE

Application Procedure Schedule

◆ The period for applications is <u>October 1~November 20, 2018</u> for the school year starting <u>April 4, 2019</u>.

^{*}From the second year, students who show high academic performance (above GPA 3.0) are eligible for the tuition fee.

International students entering GSE are eligible for a substantial tuition scholarship. Scholarships are available beginning in the first year, but students must maintain GPA 3.0 each year to continue their scholarships.

Additional Expenses

In addition to these school-based fees, students should be prepared for additional living expenses that include:

- Housing fees (private student apartments can run from \(\pm\)30,000-50,000)
- National Health Insurance (¥25,000 yearly)
- Textbooks (¥10,000~ per semester)

Scholarships for Living Expenses

International students are also eligible for scholarships for living expenses ranging from \$30,000-70,000/month. Our International Affairs Office can help you apply for these scholarships.
