Thank you very much for your cooperation as always.

We'd like to inform you about the FY 2022 HJU Gakujutsu Kenkyu Josei (HJU Gakujutsu Grant). We're sending you copies of 4 kinds of application forms as follows, with some explanatory notes in English.

- 1. **Kojin-kenkyu** (grant for the study that **an individual** carries out. <u>Not the same</u> as Kojin-kenkyu-hi (in short, Koken) which every teacher is paid without applying)
- 2. Kyodo-kenkyu (grant for the study that a group carries out.)
- 3. Gakujutsu-tosho-shuppan-josei (publishing grant)
- 4. Gakkai-tokubetsu-josei (operating expenses grant of an academic conference)

Also, you'll see other 2 kinds of relevant documents as follows:

- a. Application Guidelines for FY 2022 Gakujutsu Grant (Japanese version only, pp.1-3.)
- b. Review Section Table for Kakenhi

Under the HJU rule of Gakujutsu Grant (Japanese version only), you are not allowed to apply for 1 and 2 at the same time. For example, when you are a principal investigator of **Kojin-kenkyu** (1), you may not take any role (a principal investigator or a co-investigator) in **Kyodo-kenkyu** (2) group. To divide the equal opportunity for every researcher here to carry out his/her research activity during FY 2021, the review committee of Gakujutsu Grant will not welcome you join the both research projects. However, the HJU rule allows you to apply for 1 or 2 and 3 or 4 at one time. For example, you can apply for **Kyodo-kenkyu** (2) as a principal investigator and **Gakujutsu-tosho-shuppan-josei** (3) as a writer.

The application forms must be submitted to the office or the mailbox of Sogo-kenkyu-sho (Research Institute) or Shomu-ka by <u>the following due dates</u>. Also, it is necessary for you to fill in every academic information related to your research plan on **researchmap** (https://researchmap.jp/).

- 1. Kojin-kenkyu: Monday, April 18, 2022, 17:00
- 2. Kyodo-kenkyu: Monday, April 18, 2022, 17:00
- 3. Gakujutsu-tosho-shuppan-josei: Monday, September 5, 2022, 17:00
- 4. Gakkai-tokubetsu-josei: Monday, April 18, 2022 17:00
